and I shall overcome! Yet not I, but through Christ in me.

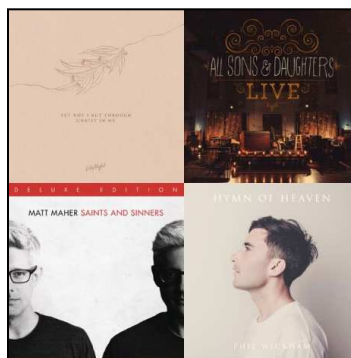
No fate I dread, I know I am forgiven, the future sure, the price,
