 - How can this passage practically help you with your walk with Christ this week AND in bringing Christ to someone else?
 - What stand out to you the most from these two passages on Christ’s love for us?

While I was a slave to sin, Jesus died for me. Yes, He died for me.

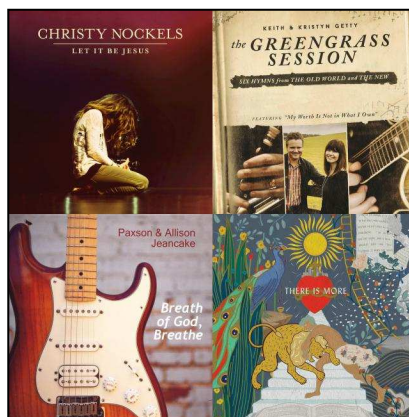
I am chosen, not forsaken. I am who You say I am.
