Digging Deeper

- Read Joshua 1:1-11 and answer the following:
 - o What factors in their context would justify the Israelites being afraid or tentative?
 - O What promises do you see God giving to Joshua and the Israelites?
 - Why would God give the guidance of meditating on His Word/Law when the issue for the Israelites is fear and timidity?
 - What is your favorite promise that God gives in this passage and why?
- ❖ With Joshua 1 in mind, read 2 Tim. 1:8-10.
 - o How does a spirit of timidity and fear manifest itself in your life?
 - o Who/What is/are the source(s) of fear and timidity in our lives?
 - How do "power, of love and of self-discipline" relate to taking on a spiritually risky and difficult task?
 - o Ultimately, how is spiritual courage and obedience manifested in our lives?
- What are you involved in at the moment that you would categorize as spiritually risky and difficult for you?
- ❖ Is there something risky or difficult that God has been leading you to do that you have backed away from due to fear or uncertainty?
- ❖ As a group pray for one another to be spiritually strong and courageous.

Think About It!

Joshua was very highly favored in the matter of promises. The promises given him by God were broadly comprehensive and exceedingly encouraging. But Joshua was not therefore to say within himself, "These covenant engagements will surely be fulfilled, and I may

therefore sit still and do nothing." On the contrary, because God had decreed that the land should be conquered, Joshua was to be diligent to lead the people onward to battle. He was not to use the promise as a couch upon which his indolence might luxuriate, but as a girdle wherewith to gird up his loins for future activity... By the oath, by the promise, by the covenant, and by the blood which sealeth it, we are exhorted continually to be at work for Christ, since we are saved in order that we may serve him, in the power of the Holy Ghost, with heart, and soul, and strength. (Charles Spurgeon)
