Earth has no sorrow that Heaven can't cure.

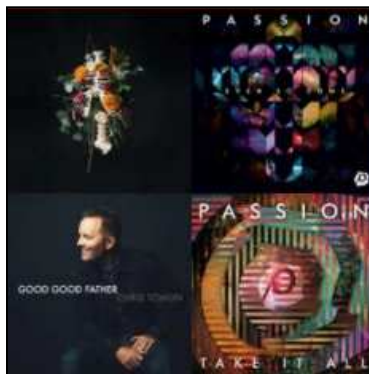
Come as you are; fall in his arms, come as you are.
